This scholarship was created and endowed by Ms. Helen Dyar King to encourage and reward members of public services. Ms. King's appreciation for the military stemmed from her first husband, Don Clark, who served in the Navy during World War II and is the basis for the designation of the Helen Dyar King fund for members or descendants of military or police personnel.

Eligibility:

- Active, former member of, or child or grandchild of any of the following who serve the public good:
 - The military
 - Law enforcement
 - Fire fighter
 - U.S. Forest Service
 - U.S. Park Service
 - U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
- Minimum grade point average of 3.00
- Financial need
- Arizona and U.S. residence for tuition purposes.
- Full-time student

Award:

Up to \$2,000 for attendance at a Maricopa Community College.

Renewal Criteria:

Recipients may apply for consideration for an additional year of funding, but there is no automatic renewal of the scholarship. All applicants, including previous recipients are considered equally in the selection process each year.

Note: *In addition to any other terms and conditions, the number and amount of all Arizona Community Foundation scholarship awards and renewals is contingent on the availability of funding.*
