Linda B. Rosenthal Scholarship



Linda B. Rosenthal was elected to the Maricopa Community College District Governing Board in 1979. She is the longest serving Governing Board member in Maricopa's history. She served formally as both secretary and president of the Board six times. She is also widely known for her work with various State and National committees, including the Arizona Association of District Governing Boards, the Arizona Community College Association, and the American Association of Women in Community Colleges. Ms. Rosenthal has received many honors and much recognition for her passionate efforts on behalf of community colleges and student success. Ms. Rosenthal ended her last term as a Maricopa Community College District Governing Board member on December 31, 2008.

- Be a female re-entry student who is returning to college after considerable time away, in order to re-enter the workforce.
- Have already completed 6 credit hours of coursework.
