Pfister Family Scholarship



Jack Pfister grew up in Prescott, Arizona and held degrees in engineering and law from The University of Arizona. He joined SRP in 1969 as an attorney and held the position of general manager from 1976 until his retirement in 1991. Pfister is well-known for his contribution to water management in Arizona, as well as charitable, government, and community causes. After his retirement from SRP, Pfister taught at The University of Arizona and served on the Arizona Board of Regents. Jack Pfister passed away on July 20, 2009 at the age of 75. The Pfister Family Scholarship, established in 1991, is just one example of Jack Pfister's unwavering support of education in Arizona.

Three awards of \$550 each for the 2009-10 academic year (\$275 per semester).

To apply you must:

- Plan to attend a Maricopa Community College.
- Explain financial need.
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA, which you must maintain throughout the academic year to remain eligible.
- Enroll in a minimum of 6 hours per semester during the 2009-2010 academic year.
- Be enrolled in a public service program of study, including political science, social work, public health, environmental studies, or public administration.
- Have already completed a minimum of 24 hours of public service coursework.
- Submit a personal essay outlining your financial need, your academic and career goals, and your inspiration for choosing a career in public service.
- Submit one letter of recommendation.
