

Maricopa Community Colleges Student Declaration of Citizenship or Status

State law now requires that a person who is not a citizen or legal resident of the United States or who is without lawful immigration status is not entitled to classification as an in-state student pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1802 or entitled to classification as a county resident pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1802.01. Although you have previously enrolled at this or another Maricopa Community College, it is important that you provide this information, even if you have been asked to provide similar information in the past.

Failure to provide the information requested below may result in your being now classified as out-of-state for tuition and fee purposes. The responsibility of providing the proper residency classification is placed upon the student. Any student who falsifies his/her residency may be subject to dismissal from the college and/or criminal action.
